

Introduction to Sustainable Leadership – E-learning.



Background

This course has been developed for people interested in exploring Lasting Leadership® in the non-profit sector. It looks at each of the myths and paradoxes discussed in the Lasting Leadership Guide. This free course will run from 8th May to 30th June 2023 and will involve up to 20 participants. It's relevant for board members, managers or anyone interested in sustainable leadership.

The course content

The bulk of the course activities are designed to be done independently at your own pace and will take roughly six hours to complete.

Each section of the course has the same format:

- some bite-sized information introducing a paradox, challenge or myth, including short videos.
- an activity to start thinking about the topic.
- a reflective journal to download with some prompt questions to help you to think about the topic in the context of your own practice.
- a collaborative forum to gather examples, experiences and resources across participants.
