

Introduction to Sustainable Leadership – E-learning pilot.



Background

This course has been developed for people interested in exploring Lasting Leadership® in the non-profit sector. It looks at each of the myths and paradoxes discussed in the [Lasting Leadership Guide](#). The pilot will run over February and March 2021 and will involve up to 20 participants. It's relevant for board members, managers or anyone interested in sustainable leadership.

The course content

The bulk of the course activities are designed to be done independently at your own pace and will take roughly six hours to complete.

Each section of the course has the same format:

- some bite-sized information introducing a paradox, challenge or myth, including a short video and/or animation
- an activity to start thinking about the topic
- a reflective journal to download with some prompt questions to help you to think about the topic in the context of your own practice
- a collaborative forum to gather examples, experiences and resources across participants.



Peer support



There are three opportunities to meet with other participants online. These last for an hour each and are optional to attend. It's a chance to share practice and challenges with supportive peers; to learn from each other and develop your thinking.
